Museum Hundertwasser

The Museum Hundertwasser presents a unique cross-section of the oeuvre of the Austrian artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser (1928–2000), including key paintings as well as graphic works, applied art, architectural designs and examples of the artist's ecological commitment. **The Museum Hundertwasser is part of KUNST HAUS WIEN**, which was established in 1991 on the basis of the Hundertwasser's philosophy and artistic principles. The architectural remodelling of the former Thonet furniture factory was effected in accordance with Hundertwasser's own designs. **Vienna's first "green museum"** also gives its visitors the chance to experience Friedensreich Hundertwasser's visionary ecological commitment – he experimented with grass roofs and planted trees in building facades.

In the past temporary exhibitions have been devoted to such illustrious artists as Andy Warhol, Christo, Picasso, Keith Haring, Niki de Saint Phalle and many others, as well as to world-famous photographers.
