Austrian **photographer Elfie Semotan** became **internationally known** for her fashion and advertising photography. Her photographic approach has been guided from the beginning by the idea of capturing a person's personality. Semotan **stages and constructs multifaceted stories** within the image format.

She often uses the **visual arts** as a **source of inspiration**. Adaptations and homages to works of art and artists can be found in several of her series, such as *Inspired by Lucian Freud* (1997), *Präraffaeliten* (2005) and in works that refer to iconic images by famous photographers such as Diane Arbus, John Coplans, Robert Frank or Irving Penn.

In addition to art historical quotations, her passion for art is also reflected in her portraits of **artists and studio photographs**: for example, of Marina Abramovic, Louise Bourgeois, Bruno Gironcoli, Raymond Pettibon or Franz West. The individual expression of the sitters is a consistent characteristic of these photographs. In the studio photographs, it is her attentive view of the space itself that makes them special.

For Semotan, nature is a place of retreat and creativity. Her origins and her house in rural southern Burgenland, which she occupies alongside domiciles in Vienna and New York, play an important role here. Whether analogue or digital, photographed in black and white or in colour, Semotan has captured moments of the poetic in her landscape photographs and still lifes.

On the occasion of her 80th birthday, KUNST HAUS WIEN pays tribute to Elfie Semotan with a comprehensive retrospective. The exhibition *Position and Pose* spans six decades of her work and makes Semotan's photographic cosmos tangible with specific approaches to the medium of photography. Around 150 works from her diverse artistic oeuvre will be on display.

Elfie Semotan, born in Wels in 1941, attended the Hetzendorf fashion school in Vienna and then went to Paris at the age of 20. There she worked as a mannequin for several years and gained insight into the world of fashion and photography. Elfie Semotan successfully and publicly shaped the Austrian fashion and advertising scene. In the 1990s Semotan photographed fashion spreads for major labels with models such as Naomi Campbell or Cordula Reyer and portraits of famous personalities. Her photographs appear in international magazines such as Vogue, i-D, Elle, Esquire, Marie Claire, Harper's Bazaar and The New Yorker. Elfie Semotan lives in Vienna, New York and Jennersdorf/Burgenland
